Please refer to NFIR's representation dated 23.07.2018 addressed to Hon'ble MR
requesting intervention of Hon'ble for obtaining approval of Ministry of Finance (MoF) for
upgradation GP-4600 to GP-4800.

2. With respect to above, it is stated that Railway Board have been making persistent
efforts with various levels for obtaining approval of proposal sent to MoF vide Board's OM
dated 08.02.2017 proposing revision of pay structure of Sr. Supervisors in Group 'C' of all
departments (other than Account Department) to upgrade 75% of such Supervisor posts from
Level-7 (erstwhile GP-4600) to Level-8 (erstwhile GP-4800) and to bring parity in the pay
scales of Group 'B' Officers Accounts/Non-Accounts Department.

3. It has already been intimated to NFIR through ATS on PNM-NFIR Item Nos. 3 &
10/2018 that a D.O. letter dated 20.04.2017 was sent from Hon'ble MR to Hon'ble FM for
expediting approval on above proposal. Thereafter, a reminder dated 15.05.2018 from EDPC-
II to JS(Pers)/MoF was also sent in this connection. Recently, a D.O. letter dated 13.07.2018
(Annex-I) from Board(CRB) to Finance Secretary has also been sent requesting them to
expedite approval on Board's proposal dated 08.02.2017.

Sr,

I would like to bring to your kind attention this Ministry's proposal dated 08.02.2017 (copy annexed as **Annexure 'A'**) seeking concurrence of Ministry of Finance on the following:


- (i) Revision of Pay Levels of Group 'B' Officers of all Railway Departments (other than Accounts Department) to Level-9 of the 7th CPC Pay Matrix, on par with the Pay Levels of Group 'B' Officers of the Accounts Department of Railways.
- (ii) Revision of the pay structure of Senior Supervisors in Group 'C' of all Departments (other than Accounts Department) to upgrade 75% of such Supervisory posts from Level-7 (erstwhile GP-4600) to Level-8 (erstwhile GP-4800).

2. The aforesaid proposal was further pursued through D.O. letter from Hon'ble Minister of Railways dated 20.04.2017 (**Annexure 'B'**) followed by a reminder dated 15.05.2018 (**Annexure 'C'**).

3. This is a proposal that seeks to mitigate the disparity in relativity/pay scale between Group 'B' officers and Supervisors of Accounts and Non-accounts Departments that has occurred over the past two Pay Commissions. Importantly, it also seeks to provide an avenue of promotion to qualify Senior Supervisors in GP 4600/- to mitigate stagnation in this category. As the proposal addresses crucial concerns of sensitive front-line Officers & Supervisors of Indian Railways, it is requested that this may be considered on priority. Delay is leading to considerable resentment among affected employees, which has potentially adverse implications on train operations & safety. An early positive action in the matter is therefore solicited.
